

**National Workshop on Inspiration for Research : YOU CAN in Department of
Chemistry, MNNIT Allahabad**

Report

The day 19 December 2014, Department of Chemistry, MNNIT Allahabad started **National Workshop on Inspiration for Research : YOU CAN** (December 19 to 21, 2014). The workshop was inaugurated by Prof. R.K.Srivastava, Dean (Research & Consultancy) and Coordinator, TEQIP-II, MNNIT Allahabad by lighting the lamp. A welcome lecture and brief introduction of the Chemistry department was given by Prof. S.S. Narvi, Head of the Chemistry Department. The brief introduction about the workshop was given by Prof. P.K. Dutta, Convener-workshop. The inaugural lecture was given by Dean (R&C) of MNNIT which includes his experiences during research and fostering innovation to research. Firstly he welcomed all participants who came from different institutions and then given some important tips to participants regarding motivation to research. He encouraged participants to do original research instead of derivative research and thus to identifying his/her own caliber. He said that inspiration is the key to innovation and it leads to new findings. The society as well as the educational institutions are the bench marks to direct for proper environment towards fostering innovations which comes either from inner self or nurturing habits of individuals. The young mind has enough potentiality to make excellence in research and they have proved and can prove. Such kind of workshop encouraged the participants for interdisciplinary research and also emphasized that research should be related to our societal problems so that it may be beneficial to our community. The workshop focused on personality development and Intellectual Property Rights and patent rights of innovations also. Finally Dr. Tamal Ghosh, Coordinator-workshop offers vote of thanks to all participants and other distinguished gathering. After inauguration and tea break, the interaction session (which divided into three batches) was conducted by Prof. S.S. Narvi, Prof. P.K. Dutta and Dr. Tamal Ghosh. Just after lunch the personality development lectures by Col. (Retd.) Shekhar Singh was conducted on 19 Dec. (AN) and 20 Dec. first meeting. The second day several lectures in sciences and engineering were delivered by Dr. S.N. Pandey (Phys.), Prof. M.M. Gore (CSED), Dr. Shivesh Sharma (BT), Prof. H.S. Goyal (MED), and Dr. Manoj Kumar (Maths.). The last day, 21 Dec. lecture started by Dr. Sushil Kumar (ChED) on chemical engineering and interdisciplinary fields of research which was continued by Ms. Tanvi Jain, Young Scientist Awardee (ICS) and research scholar in ChED and chemistry department both. The intellectual property and patent rights were deliberated by Mr. Vikas Asawat, Patent right activist, Noida. Total 15 lectures were delivered in 3 days workshop. In valedictory programme, Former Prof. Ashok Mahan, Allahabad University advised the participants to follow the path of innovation which they have acquired through knowledge learning process for betterment in their future ambition. The workshop was ended by distribution of certificates among the participants. Total 81 participants from UG/PG courses of various disciplines from different institutions attended the workshop.
