## Places to Visit

The “Kumbh Nagari” Allahabad is major tourist attraction in India from all over the world. The conference secretariat may offer a tour package to visit the nearby places on request only. The major tourist attractions in the city are-

Allahabad Fort is situated on the bank of the Yamuna, near to Sangam. This magnificent fort was built by Akbar in 1583; Ashoka Pillar stands tall inside the Allahabad Fort, built by Akbar, and is the polished sandstone Ashoka Pillar. Swaraj Bhawan and Anand Bhawan were the legacies of Motilal Nehru, a freedom fighter and father of Jawaharlal Nehru, and were dedicated to nation by them. Allahabad Museum near Chandra Shekhar Azad Park, preserves the paintings of Nicholas Roerich, terracotta figurines, Rajasthani miniatures, coins and stone sculptures from the 2nd century BC till date.

In addition, other tourist attraction near Prayagraj is Varanasi- an ancient, religious and culturally rich city on the banks of the ganges, 120 Km far from Allahabad.



## The Sangam City

Prayagraj, formerly known as Prayaga, is a sacred city where the Ganga, Yamuna, and the mythical Saraswati rivers meet at the Triveni Sangam, a confluence considered highly spiritual in Hinduism. A holy dip at this confluence is believed to absolve one's sins and break the cycle of rebirth. As one of India's oldest cities, it holds a significant place in Hindu scriptures and is revered for its deep cultural and religious history.

**Weather:** The month of March marks the onset of summers in north India. The average temperature in Allahabad in October-November is fairly hot at 24.5 °C with minimum of 16 °C and maximum around 35 °C.

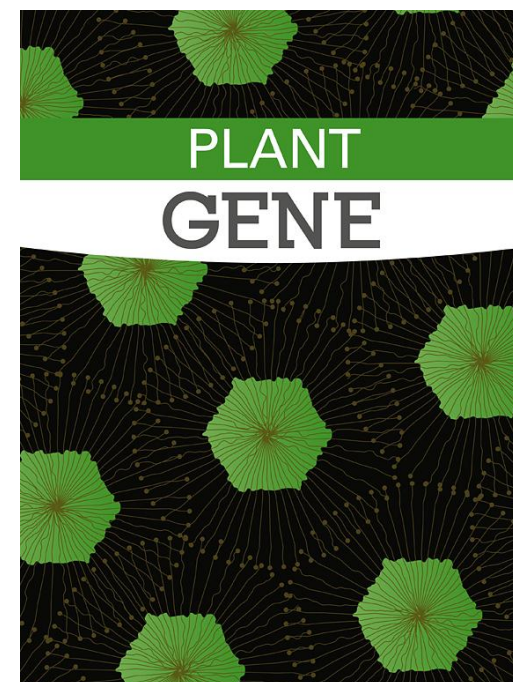
